Port Police Will Launch Traffic Radar Enforcement

Drivers cautioned to follow speed zones along Route 11

Piti, Guam, July 9, 2010: The Port Authority of Guam Port Police will begin radar traffic enforcement Monday along Route 11 in Piti.

"We want to caution members of the public to obey all traffic laws as they travel through this area," said Port Police Chief Doris Aguero. "This is a heavy industrial zone and can be quite hazardous with all the large trucks moving in and out of the area."

Aguero said the speed limit travelling from Marine Drive into the Port Authority is 25 miles per hour. Leaving the area toward Marine Drive the speed zone is 35 miles per hour.

"Our officers have undergone training on the use of the radar gun by members of the Airport Police Department," Aguero said. She added that the Airport Police donated a radar gun to Port Police for their use. "I want to thank Airport Police Chief Robert Camacho for his assistance and for giving our officers the training they needed to utilize the radar guns."

Radar enforcement will begin on Monday morning.
