1. AMEND TO CHANGE BID OPENING ON PAGE 3 OF 96.

2. AMEND TO CHANGE DURATION OF PROJECT ON PAGE 59 OF 96:

FROM:

Contractor shall complete all required services under this Agreement within **Two Hundred and Forty- Three (243)** days from issuance of a Notice to Proceed by the Port.

TO NOW READ:

Contractor shall complete all required services under this Agreement within **Two Hundred Seventy-Three (273)** days from issuance of a Notice to Proceed by the Port.

3. AMEND SPECIFICATIONS ON PAGE 85 OF 96 PART 2 – PRODUCTS 2.04 FENDER RUBBERS:

FROM:

A. Replacement fender rubbers shall be AH-600 as manufactured by Maritime International.

TO NOW READ:

A. Replacement fender rubbers may be AH-600 or APPROVED EQUAL specifications. It is responsibility of the Contractor to source out the materials required for this project. Any statements naming any supplier is stricken from this specification for both fendering systems.

4. AMEND SPECIFICATIONS ON PAGE 85 OF 96 PART 3 – EXECUTION 3.03 REPAIR OF CONCRETE SURFACES:

FROM:

A. After removal of the fender units, the CONTRACTOR shall repair the concrete surfaces that require repairing as shown on the Contractual Drawings.

B. Cut anchor bolts shall be grinded flush with the concrete surface.

TO NOW READ:

These item(s) A and B are stricken from the section 02480-Items 3.03.

5. AMEND SPECIFICATIONS ON PAGE 85 OF 96 PART 3 – EXECUTION 3.04 REPAIR OF FENDER FRAMES:

FROM:

A. All welding performed by the CONTRACTOR shall conform to the applicable requirements of AWS D1.1 including Section 9. Dynamically Loaded Structures.

B. The CONTRACTOR shall pressure test the fender frame after repairs to ensure water tightness of the frame.

C. The CONTRACTOR shall repaint the repaired frames with a coal tar epoxy coating as specified in Section 09960 “Coating of Marine Steel”.

TO NOW READ:

These item(s) A, B, and C are stricken from the section 02480-Items 3.04.


6. 2nd SITE VISIT to be conducted 10:00a.m., Tuesday, October 27, 2020. Meeting place will be at the Port Police Office.

All participants must have their PPES: personal floatation device (PFD), hard hats, closed toe shoes, safety vest, and face mask as the Port will not provide these items. Participants are advised to ensure they bring their proper IDs.
