- I. <u>PURPOSE</u>: To ensure that work is performed in a safe manner and that the assignment of overtime work is provided in a fair and equitable way.
- II. <u>DISCUSSION</u>: Regulations governing overtime are designed for the protection of employees by restricting the number of hours an employee will be permitted to work within a given period. The primary concern is the safety and heatlh of Authority employees and should so be interpreted.
- III. <u>COVERAGE</u>: All employees of the Authority, whether permanent or temporary, shall be governed by the provisions of this guidance.
- IV. MAXIMUM HOURS OF WORK:

The following maximum hours of work must be strictly enforced:

- (1) No employee shall be allowed to work more than 16 hours consecutively, or in one 24-hour day.
- (2) No employee shall be authorized to work more than 84 hours total within a single seven-day pay period.
- (3) No employee shall be required to work more than 28 hours within a time span of two 24-hour days.
- V. EXCEPTIONS: Exceptions to the above may be made only if the employee volunteers his/her services and has the specific approval of his/her division head. Should such an occasion arise, written documentation must be submitted by the division head to the General Manager within 48 hours of such occurrence.
