ALL REVISIONS ARE MARKED WITH AN ASTERISK (*)			
<p>Effective immediately, fishes given to the employees are required to have either one of the following fish passes before it will be allowed to exit the Port compound:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <u>INDIVIDUAL PASS</u> - Pass, one for each employee, properly signed by any one of the following:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Owner of cargo;b. Ship's agent;c. Ship's captain;d. Port supervisor assigned to the fish operation (prior authorization from A, B, or C above on a voyage to voyage basis.)2. <u>MULTIPLE PASS</u> - Pass assigned to a group of employees leaving the Port at the same time properly signed by any one of the following:<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Owner of cargo;b. Ship's agent;c. Ship's captain;d. Port supervisor assigned to the fish operation (prior authorization from A, B, or C above on a voyage to voyage basis.) <p>Security personnel are requested to implement and enforce this policy and Port personnel are asked to adhere to the aforesaid.</p>
