Fuel and cargo operations continue at the Port

Piti, Guam, June 4, 2023: Operations are ongoing at F1 Pier to discharge fuel off of the Sophia tanker.

"There remains a sufficient supply of fuel on the island, and the crisis at the pump seems to be alleviated thanks to a tremendous amount of work and support from the local and federal governments, petroleum companies, industry partners and stakeholders," said Port Authority of Guam General Manager Rory J. Respicio.

Inchcape's Sophia tanker is estimated to depart at 10 p.m. today with the Chang Hang Kai tanker making a return to discharge more petroleum products.

Gantry 5 is currently working on APL's CGM Dakar to offload 281 local containers of which 20 are reefers. One hundred seventy-three containers have been discharged as of press time. CGM Dakar is also estimated to depart at 10 p.m. this evening.

Gantry 6 operations for Kyowa Shipping Line's Kyowa Stork continue with break bulk discharge ongoing and load backs thereafter. Ninety-nine containers have been discharged consisting of a mix of full, empty, and transshipment cargo. Kyowa Stork is estimated to leave at 7 p.m. this evening.

Guam Marianas Express Line's Kota Ratu is scheduled to arrive at 6 a.m., on June 4, 2023, which is slated to discharge 191 containers (2 reefers, 6 transshipments).
